#### I. Length of Authorization 1,17,29

Coverage will be provided as follows:

- o Castleman Disease: 4 months and may be renewed
- o Cytokine Release Syndrome: 4 doses only and may NOT be renewed
- o Immune Checkpoint Inhibitor Related Toxicities: 1 dose only and may NOT be renewed
- o Giant Cell Arteritis: 1 year of therapy
- o All other indications: 6 months and may be renewed.

#### **II.** Dosing Limits

o Actemra 80 mg/4 mL vial: 1 vial per 14 days

• Patient is at least 18 years of age (unless otherwise specified); **AND** 

#### Universal Criteria <sup>1</sup>

- Patient has been evaluated and screened for the presence of latent tuberculosis (TB)
  infection prior to initiating treatment and will receive ongoing monitoring for presence of TB
  during treatment; AND
- Patient does not have an active infection, including clinically important localized infections;
   AND
- Patient will not receive live vaccines during therapy; AND
- Patient is not on concurrent treatment with another TNF-inhibitor, biologic response
  modifier or other non-biologic agent (i.e., apremilast, tofacitinib, baricitinib, upadacitinib,
  etc.), unless otherwise specified; AND

#### Rheumatoid Arthritis † 1,19,27

- Physician has assessed baseline disease severity utilizing an objective measure/tool; AND
- Documented moderate to severe active disease; AND
- Patient has had at least a 3 month trial and failed previous therapy with ONE oral disease modifying anti-rheumatic agent (DMARD) such as methotrexate, azathioprine, auranofin, hydroxychloroquine, penicillamine, sulfasalazine, leflunomide, etc.; **AND**
- May be used as a single agent or in combination with methotrexate or other non-biologic DMARDs (e.g., methotrexate, hydroxychloroquine, leflunomide, sulfasalazine, etc.)
- Patient must have failed or experienced intolerable side effects to:
  - TWO (2) or more of the following: certolizumab (Cimzia), adalimumab (Humira), or golimumab (Simponi/Simponi ARIA); **AND**
  - BOTH sarilumab (Kevzara) and tofacitinib (Xeljanz)

#### Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis (JIA) † Φ 1,5,18

- Patient is at least 2 years of age; AND
- Physician has assessed baseline disease severity utilizing an objective measure/tool; AND
- Patient has active systemic (sJIA) or polyarticular (pJIA) Φ disease; AND
- Patient has had at least a 1-month trial and failure (unless contraindicated or intolerant) of previous therapy with either oral non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) OR an oral disease-modifying anti-rheumatic agent (DMARD) (e.g., methotrexate, leflunomide, sulfasalazine, etc.); AND
- May be used as a single agent or in combination with methotrexate

Patient must have failed or experienced intolerable side effects to adalimumab (Humira)

#### Castleman Disease (B-Cell Lymphomas) ‡ 2

- Used as a single agent; AND
  - Patient has unicentric disease; AND
    - Patient is human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)-negative and human herpesvirus-8 (HHV-8)-negative; AND
    - Used as second-line therapy for relapsed or refractory disease; OR
  - Patient has multicentric disease; AND
    - Used as subsequent therapy for relapsed, refractory, or progressive disease

#### Cytokine Release Syndrome (CRS) † $\Phi$ 1,2

- Patient is at least 2 years of age; AND
  - Patient has received or will be receiving chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T cell therapy (e.g., axicabtagene ciloleucel, brexucabtagene autoleucel, idecabtagene vicleucel, lisocabtagene maraleucel, tisagenlecleucel, etc.); AND
    - Tocilizumab is being ordered to have on-hand, prior to the administration of CAR-T therapy, if needed for the treatment of CRS; OR
    - Used for management of one of the following:
      - Prolonged (>3 days) G1 CRS in patients with significant symptoms, comorbidities, and/or in elderly patients; OR
      - G1 CRS symptoms that persist >24 hours in patients who have been treated with axicabtagene ciloleucel or brexucabtagene autoleucel; OR
      - G1 CRS that develops <72 hours after infusion in patients who have been treated with lisocabtagene maraleucel; OR
      - G2-4 CRS; OR
      - G1-4 neurotoxicity as additional single-dose therapy if the patient has concurrent CRS; OR
  - Used as supportive care in patients with acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) who have severe CRS related to blinatumomab therapy

#### Management of Immune Checkpoint Inhibitor Related Toxicities ‡ 2,17,26

- Patient has been receiving therapy with an immune checkpoint inhibitor (e.g. nivolumab, pembrolizumab, atezolizumab, avelumab, durvalumab, cemiplimab, ipilimumab, dostarlimab etc.);
  - Used as additional therapy for management of giant cell arteritis; **OR**
  - Patient has severe immunotherapy-related inflammatory arthritis; AND
    - Used as additional disease modifying antirheumatic therapy; AND
      - Patient's symptoms have not improved within 1 week after starting high-dose corticosteroids; OR
      - Patient is unable to taper corticosteroids by week 2

#### Acute Graft Versus Host Disease (aGVHD) ‡ 2,20-22,28

- Patient has received a hematopoietic stem cell transplant; AND
- Used for steroid-refractory acute GVHD; AND
- Used in combination with systemic corticosteroids as additional therapy following no response to first-line therapies

#### Neuromyelitis Optica Spectrum Disorder (NMOSD) ‡ 23-25

- Patient has a confirmed diagnosis based on the following:
  - o Patient was found to be seropositive for aquaporin-4 (AQP4) IgG antibodies; AND
    - Patient has at least one core clinical characteristic §; AND
    - Alternative diagnoses have been excluded (e.g., multiple sclerosis, sarcoidosis, cancer, chronic infection, etc.); OR
  - $\circ~$  Patient was found to be serone gative for AQP-4 IgG antibodies OR has unknown AQP-4- IgG status;  $\mbox{\bf AND}$ 
    - Patient has at least two core clinical characteristics§ occurring as a result of one or more clinical attacks; AND
    - Patient experienced ALL of the following:
      - At least 1 core clinical characteristic must be optic neuritis, acute myelitis with LETM\*, or area postrema syndrome; AND
      - Dissemination in space (≥2 different core clinical characteristics); AND
      - Fulfillment of additional MRI requirements, as applicable ψ; AND
    - Alternative diagnoses have been excluded (e.g., multiple sclerosis, sarcoidosis, cancer, chronic infection, etc.);
- Used as a single agent or in combination with immunosuppressive therapy (e.g. azathioprine, methotrexate, mycophenolate, etc.)

#### Giant Cell Arteritis (GCA) † 1,29-31

- Patient has large vessel arteritis that has at some point been verified with biopsy or with imaging of the large vessels (MRI, PET-CT, or CT angiography); AND
- Patient has active disease and an elevated c-reactive protein (CRP) and erythrocyte sedimentation rate (ESR); **AND**
- Patient has had an inadequate response, contraindication, or intolerance to glucocorticoid therapy alone; AND
- Used in combination with a tapering course of glucocorticoids (NOTE: Actemra can be used alone following discontinuation of glucocorticoids.)

#### § Core Clinical Characteristics of NMOSD <sup>23</sup>

Optic neuritis

- Acute myelitis
- Area postrema syndrome: episode of otherwise unexplained hiccups or nausea and vomiting
- Acute brainstem syndrome
- Symptomatic narcolepsy or acute diencephalic clinical syndrome with NMOSD-typical diencephalic MRI lesions
- Symptomatic cerebral syndrome with NMOSD-typical brain lesions

# $\psi$ Additional MRI requirements for NMOSD without AQP4-IgG and NMOSD with unknown AQP4-IgG status $^{23}$

- Acute optic neuritis: requires brain MRI showing (a) normal findings or only nonspecific white matter lesions, OR (b) optic nerve MRI with T2-hyperintense lesion or T1-weighted gadolinium-enhancing lesion extending over >1/2 optic nerve length or involving optic chiasm
- Acute myelitis: requires associated intramedullary MRI lesion extending over ≥3 contiguous segments (LETM) OR ≥3 contiguous segments of focal spinal cord atrophy in patients with history compatible with acute myelitis
- Area postrema syndrome: requires associated dorsal medulla/area postrema lesions
- Acute brainstem syndrome: requires associated peri-ependymal brainstem lesions

#### IV. Renewal Criteria <sup>1</sup>

Coverage can be renewed based upon the following criteria:

- Patient continues to meet the universal and other indication-specific relevant criteria identified in section III; **AND**
- Absence of unacceptable toxicity from the drug. Examples of unacceptable toxicity include: serious infections, severe neutropenia, severe thrombocytopenia, severe hepatotoxicity, gastrointestinal perforation, immunosuppression, severe hypersensitivity reactions, demyelinating disorders, etc.; AND

#### **Oncology Indications**

#### Castleman Disease (B-Cell Lymphomas) <sup>2</sup>

• Disease response with treatment as defined by stabilization of disease or decrease in size of tumor or tumor spread

#### Acute Graft Versus Host Disease (aGVHD) 20-22,28

- Response to therapy with an improvement in one or more of the following:
  - Clinician assessments (e.g., NIH Skin Score, Upper GI Response Score, NIH Lung Symptom Score, etc.)
  - o Patient-reported symptoms (e.g., Lee Symptom Scale, etc.)

#### **Non-Oncology Indications**

#### Rheumatoid arthritis (RA) 12-14

• Disease response as indicated by improvement in signs and symptoms compared to baseline such as the number of tender and swollen joint counts, reduction of C-reactive protein, improvement of patient global assessment, and/or an improvement on a disease activity scoring tool [e.g. an improvement on a composite scoring index such as Disease Activity Score-28 (DAS28) of 1.2 points or more or a ≥20% improvement on the American College of Rheumatology-20 (ACR20) criteria]

#### Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis (sJIA/pJIA) 15,16

• Disease response as indicated by improvement in signs and symptoms compared to baseline such as the number of tender and swollen joint counts, reduction of C-reactive protein, improvement of patient global assessment, and/or an improvement on a disease activity scoring tool [e.g., an improvement on a composite scoring index such as Juvenile Arthritis Disease Activity Score (JADAS) or the American College of Rheumatology (ACR) Pediatric (ACR-Pedi 30) of at least 30% improvement from baseline in three of six variables].

#### Cytokine Release Syndrome 1,2

May not be renewed

#### Management of Immune Checkpoint Inhibitor Related Toxicities 17

• May not be renewed

#### NMOSD 23,24

• Disease response as indicated by stabilization/improvement in one or more of the following: neurologic symptoms as evidenced by a decrease in acute relapses, stability reduced hospitalizations, reduction/discontinuation in plasma exchange treatments, and/or reduction/discontinuation of corticosteroids without relapse

#### Giant Cell Arteritis 1,29-31

• Disease response as indicated by improvement in signs and compared to baseline such as headache, temporal artery tenderness, visual symptoms, inflammatory parameters, etc.

Cytokine Release Syndrome (CRS)	<ul> <li>Weight ≥ 30 kg</li> <li>Administer 8 mg/kg intravenously every 8 hours, if needed, up to a maximum of 4 total doses*</li> <li>Weight &lt; 30 kg</li> <li>Administer 12 mg/kg intravenously every 8 hours, if needed, up to a maximum of 4 total doses*</li> <li>*If no clinical improvement in the signs and symptoms of CRS occurs after the first dose, up to 3 additional doses may be administered. The interval between consecutive doses should be at least 8 hours. May be used with or without corticosteroids. Doses exceeding 800 mg per infusion are not recommended in CRS patients.</li> </ul>
Immune- Checkpoint Inhibitor Related Toxicities	Administer 4 mg/kg intravenously one time only
Acute GVHD	Administer 8 mg/kg intravenously, every 2-4 weeks until disease progression or unacceptable toxicity.
NMOSD	Administer 8 mg/kg intravenously, every 4 weeks
Giant Cell Arteritis	Administer 6 mg/kg intravenously, every 4 weeks  • Doses exceeding 600 mg per infusion are not recommended in GCA patients.
